Start of School

*All **7th and 8th Grade** students are to report back to school on *Wednesday, August 30th at 7:20 AM*. They will report to the GYM on the 2nd Floor. They are to wear comfortable clothing. Supply Lists

Junior High Supply List: We suggest Jr. High students have 1 to 1 1/2 inch binders-one for each class, dividers, college rule paper, colored pencils, 3x5 notecards, blue or black pens, No. 2 pencils, a hole punch and book covers.

Junior High Books are supplied by the school and must be covered. The exception is World History which will be used by the students for Gr. 7, 8, and 9. All workbooks must be purchased new.

Senior High students will receive a list of supplies from each individual teacher. However, most teachers require a 1 to 1 1/2 inch binder, college rule paper, black and blue pens, No. 2 pencils.

BOOKS & Parent Sponsored Book Sale

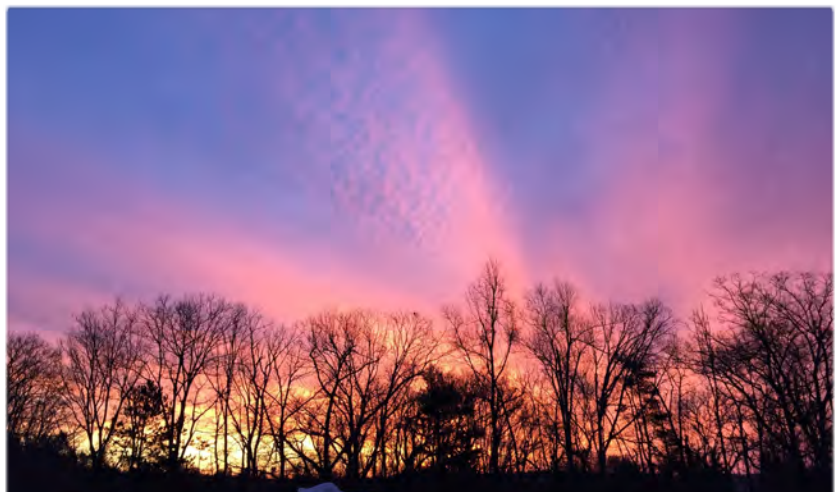
